

Questions to ask before working during COVID-19

Are you concerned about how to conduct business as safely as possible?

HERE ARE SOME SUGGESTED QUESTIONS YOU AND/OR YOUR EMPLOYEES MAY WANT TO BE ASKING:

- Have you or anyone in your home been out of the country or traveled extensively in the last 30 days?
- Is anyone in the home immune compromised?
- Is anyone in the home running a fever?
- Does anyone in the home have a cough?

OTHER THINGS TO CONSIDER FOR EACH CALL:

- Is this work essential at this time?
- If out of water, can they be hooked up to a neighbor for the time being until safer to enter a home?
- If the work is a necessity, and if the contractor has correct PPE, take all protective measures to minimize contact. This includes wearing N95 masks, gloves, and disinfecting surfaces prior to/after working.

Be sure to follow up and contact the homeowner in **10-14 days** to see if anyone in the house has changed conditions. **Remember, we are Better Together!**
